The abstract must be written into one paragraph and should be from 150 to 200 words long. It should accurately summarise the paper by clearly presenting the research problem or purpose, the methodology, main findings, and the significance of the results. **Perpetua 11**

Introduction **Perpetua 12 Bold**

The text of the article should be written in Perpetua 12, with single line spacing (1.0) throughout the entire article.

Spacing between the paragraphs is 6pts.

Article Structure

The research paper should include the following sections: **Introduction, Theoretical Framework, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, and References.**

Headings should be organized into sub-levels as follows:

- 1. Main Heading
 - 1.1. Sub-heading
 - 1.1.1. Secondary heading

Images and Maps

- Images must be digital and in JPEG format, and named using the author's name (e.g., AuthorName_Image1.JPEG).
- The number of images and maps should be limited to essential elements only, with a maximum of five (5) items in total.

Tables and Figures

- Titles must be placed above tables and below figures, numbered sequentially, and written in Bold, size 12.
- Sources must be written under the tables and the figures in size 9.

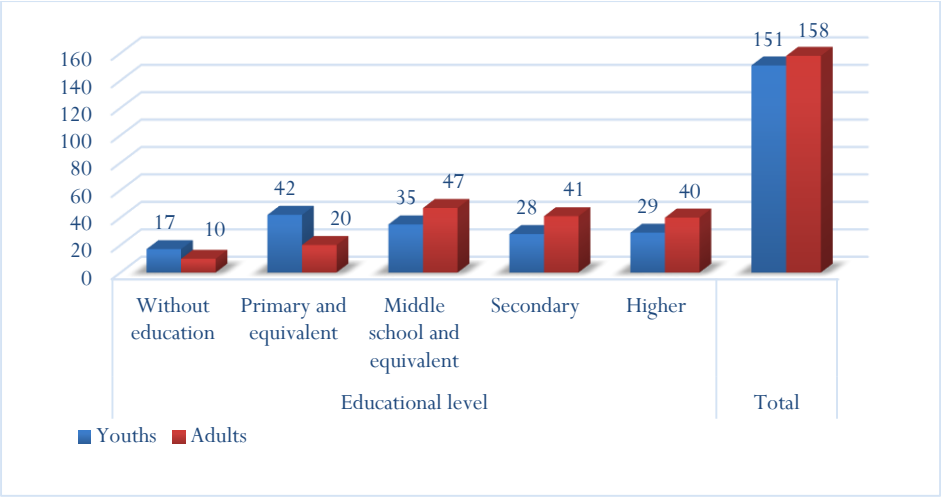


Figure 1: Level of education of the respondents

Citation and Referencing

- Articles follow an adapted APA style.
- In-text citations must correspond exactly to the reference list, and vice versa.
- In-text citation format: for paraphrased ideas (Last Name, Year); for a direct quote (Last Name, Year, p. Page number)

References

- The list of references should be presented at the end of the article, arranged alphabetically, without categorizing them under separate headings.
- A minimum of 15 scholarly references is recommended.

Article length and Formatting

- Strict adherence to the journal template (fonts, sizes, margins) is mandatory.

Page Size: Width: 15.5 cm; Height: 23 cm

Margins: Top :1.5 cm; Bottom: 1.5cm; Right: 2.5 cm; Left: 2cm

- The article should be between **15 and 20 pages**, including references.
- Appendices are not allowed.
